- Changing of positions from Chair/Vice Chair to President/Vice President
- Addition of a Parliamentarian
- Removal of the Organizing Director Office
- Addition of a Student Life Office
- 5 more representative spots for student organizations
- Clearer procedures for vacancies of officer positions
- A finance board
- Allows for typographical errors to be corrected without going through elections
