February 4 - March 15	<b>Referenda authors gather petitions or sponsorship from SUA, GSA, and/or College governments for referenda to be placed on ballot</b>	Referenda authors have four weeks to obtain sponsorship and/or signatures.
March 15	<b>Election Ballot Form and Attachments (Sponsor Confirmation) due to Dean of Students</b>	Deadline: 5:00 pm
March 16 - April 5	<b>Dean of Students verifies signatures on petitions and sponsorship forms and notifies authors if they have met requirements to proceed</b>	
Week of April 8	<b>Referenda Authors notified of eligibility to proceed in elections process. Campaign Meeting with all Referenda Authors.</b>	This is a mandatory meeting for all referenda authors to discuss the campaigning period, advertising, etc.
April 8	<b>Referenda campaigns may begin</b>	
April 8	<b>Opinion Poll Language due to Elections Commissioner</b>	
May 3	<b>Pro/Con statements due to Dean of Students (larojas@ucsc.edu)</b>	
Early May	<b>Elections Forum</b>	Date and Time: TBD
May 15	<b>Voting begins</b>	Voting begins at 12:00 am
May 21	<b>Voting ends</b>	Voting ends at 11:59 pm
